The impact of the summer school has been:

- 1) Increased confidence of Year 7 learners starting in September;
- 2) Increased engagement of Year 7 learners in academic subjects studied during the summer school programme;
- 3) Greater communication between Year 7 parents/carers and school;
- 4) Greater staff understanding of pastoral needs of learners;
- 5) Positive attitudes towards health and fitness.
- 6) A week-long programme of activities for all learners involved.
